OASIS WATER PARK FACT SHEET

- FEATURES:**
- Private access for resort guests only
 - Seven acres of water recreation – bigger than six football fields of fun
 - Full-time lifeguards on duty
 - Heated water allows year-round access
 - Park accommodates up to 3,000 guests
 - On-site bar, restaurant grill and gift shop
 - Open to resort guests and Arizona Grand Athletic Club members only
 - Named one of the Top Ten Theme Parks by the Travel Channel
 - One of the nation's largest resort water parks and voted best water park in Arizona by the Arizona Republic
 - Island Nights weekend entertainment features a dinner buffet, live performances by Arizona Grand Jam Dancers, interactive DJ and dive-in movies

- SLIDE CANYON TOWER:**
- 83-foot high Slide Canyon Tower, the equivalent of an eight story building, has three thrilling slide rides with speeds up to 35mph:
 - **Free-Fall Slide** – Dramatic 67-foot drop extends 225 feet long, sending riders through a run-out waterspout at the bottom
 - **Roadrunner Slide** – Slight horizontal start quickly becomes a thrilling, 67-foot drop, descending 220 feet into a second run-out waterspout
 - **Sidewinder Slide** – Gradual 42-foot drop twists and curves 300 feet before entering a three-and-one-half foot deep splash pool
 - * Must be 48" to ride water slides

- OASIS WAVE POOL:**
- 10,000 sq. ft.
 - Zero-entry with a gradual descent to five-foot depth
 - Two-foot action waves simulate open water swells
 - Cascading lagoon-style waterfall
 - Active sport area for water volleyball and basketball

- ZUNI ACTIVE RIVER:**
- 950 feet long, 12 feet wide
 - First side-by-side river for double inner tubing in Phoenix
 - Rolling river effect adds an element of excitement
 - Arching water jets and misting enhance refreshment
 - Three arching bridges support pedestrian traffic over the river
 - River surrounds recently expanded, lushly shaded lawn areas for family fun and lounging

- WILD CAT SPRINGS:**
- 800 sq. ft. area designed with the littlest guest in mind
 - Six water jets on a water spray deck for the ultimate kid play
 - In the pool, an additional three arching jets spray water
